ROME, ITALY



The focus of the meeting was equipping educators and facilitators with innovative methods to strengthen self-awareness, social-emotional skills and digital competencies. Twentyfour participants engaged in a dynamic program that combined theoretical learning with hands-on workshops designed to inspire and empower.

During the first two days, experts from the partner organizations led a series of Emotional Workshops, which will become part of the DIST-SEED Toolkit. These workshops explored topics such as mental health and well-being, understanding and managing emotions, responsible decision-making, teamwork skills, and emotional intelligence. Through interactive sessions, participants shared their expertise, evaluated the effectiveness of the workshops, and contributed to refining these tools for future use.

From October 22nd to 24th 2024, the DIST-SEED project organized its second Learning, Teaching, and Training Activity (LTTA) in the vibrant Trastevere neighborhood of Rome, Italy. This three-day event brought together participants from six partner countries, including team members from the seven participating organizations and invited adult educators and facilitators.



The LTTA aimed not only to share and test the workshops developed by the project but also to foster collaboration and co-creation among educators. By engaging directly with the materials, participants provided valuable feedback that will inform the ongoing development of the Toolkit for Social-Emotional Education through Digital Storytelling.

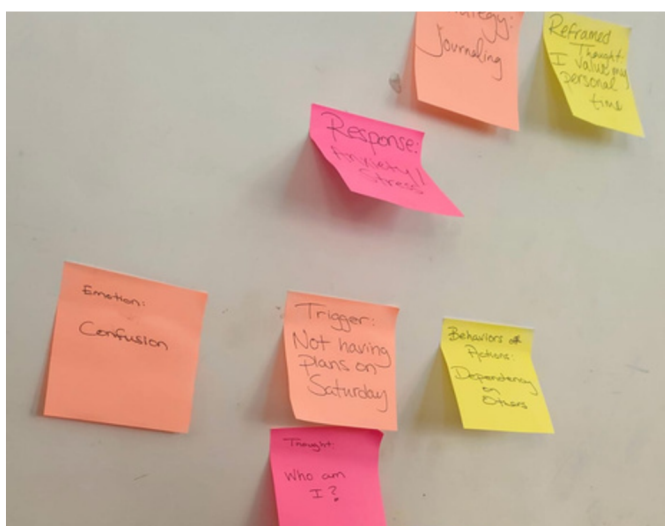

Building on the themes of emotional education, they collaboratively brainstormed innovative approaches to enhance adult learning through digital storytelling.



A highlight of the meeting was the recording of the very first materials for the Digital Stories for Socio-Emotional Education. This creative activity saw educators step into the role of storytellers, demonstrating how emotional narratives can become a powerful educational tool.



The next phase will see the partners preparing the content for the DIST-SEED Toolkit for Social-Emotional Education through Digital Storytelling, ensuring it is accessible and practical for educators across diverse contexts.
